Band Fair Share & Payment Agreement

Parents or Guardians of students participating in the Ashley Ridge Marching Band are required to review, sign, and return this Fair Share Agreement for the 2023-2024 school year.

It is our policy that no student will ever be kept from participation due to financial hardship. We offer fundraising opportunities to help students offset the costs of membership and participation in band. Participation in fundraisers can mean that no out-of-pocket fair share costs are needed!

Any family for whom the funds are a problem should notify the Band Director and Band Booster President to make arrangements and/or adjustments to the Fair Share schedule. Notification can be made by completing a Hardship Request Form located on the band website (https://www.arhsbands.org/hardship-request). All hardship requests are due by **August 30**th.

Payments can be made each month through the band website (https://www.arhsbands.org/dues), with cash, or by check. Make checks out to ARHS Band Boosters. Fundraiser credits will be applied to Fair Share amounts approximately two weeks after the end of each fundraiser and will show on the following Cuttime statement.

This signed agreement and payment confirms that your student is participating in the Ashley Ridge Marching Band for the 2023-2024 school year. You will receive billing statements and remittance information each month. If you believe you are unable to fulfill the terms of this agreement, please contact the Ashley Ridge Band Boosters.

Volunteer Opportunities

The Ashley Ridge Band Boosters is a volunteer organization whose purpose is to support the band and its directors in any way possible. In order to do that, we rely on parents donating their time and abilities in a number of areas. Please indicate below which areas/committees you are interested in helping. Concessions – Including, but not limited to setting up the concession stands, stocking & organizing, running registers, cooking (we use grills and fryers), end of season clean out. Thursday and Friday nights during football. ☐ **Fundraising** - Set up and organize all fundraiser events, both individual and full band. This includes contacting vendors and location owners, ensuring supplies for events are provided where needed, distributing fundraiser items once they have been received. Various times throughout the school year. ☐ **Uniforms** – Sizing band members and assigning & labeling appropriate uniform pieces, hemming pants, sewing on stir-ups, cleaning uniforms. Sizing is done during summer band camp, cleaning and upkeep throughout marching season. *You do NOT need to know how to sew to help in this area; there are plenty of opportunities here that don't include needle and thread. ☐ **Props** – Construction and maintenance of all props needed for marching band and winter guard seasons. ☐ Snacks/Water – Prepping and serving snacks during band camp and Saturday practices. The Boosters provide various fresh fruit snacks during these times. Fruit needs to be cut, prepped, and bagged; water jugs need to be filled with ice water. Prepackaged snacks are distributed in the afternoons and at summer evening practices. \square Competitions – Several opportunities exist here: bagging prepackaged snacks for the band, loading trailers, moving props and pit equipment at the event, setting up and serving meals. ☐ **Driving & Pulling Trailers** – Do you own at least a three-quarter ton truck with a controller for electric brakes? We are in need of someone who can pull our red equipment trailer to competitions, away football games, and parades. Are you licensed to drive a tractor trailer and have access to a rig? We currently have a volunteer to pull our large trailer, but need will need a back-up person. ☐ **Committee Chair** – Interested in heading up one of the areas listed above? Check the box here. All committee chairs will work closely with and report to an assigned Booster Board Member. Please keep in mind this not an exhaustive list of volunteer opportunities. As events come up, we will

- 1. I understand that the Marching Band program cannot be used as a disciplinary tool during the school year as it pertains to keeping students out of rehearsals or performances because of grades, behavior, or because they need to do housework. If there is a discipline issue, please let us know. We want to work as a team to help the student at home and at school.
- 2. I understand the cost and commitment of having my child participate in the Ashley Ridge Marching Band. The fair share is \$500 for all 9th 12th Grade members and \$400 for 8th grade band members. The fair share goes into the general fund. Items covered in the general fund include, but are not limited to: banking charges, insurance, staff, music, design, competition fees, equipment, and any other operational costs for the band.
- 3. I understand that this is a team. I agree that unless medically necessary, students cannot miss rehearsals. I understand that this is a team which needs volunteer participation from all member families. Participation in group fundraising events and volunteering is critical to our ability to provide quality experiences for all students in the band program.
- 4. I agree to communicate. We encourage open lines of communication between parents, students, boosters, and directors. If there are ever any issues or concerns that could affect a student's ability to participate or meet his or her obligations, please reach out and let us help find a solution.
